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#### NAPO's Priority Votes 113<sup>th</sup> Congress, United States Senate

1. **Vote #15:** S.47 – Violence Against Women Act Reauthorization -- Anti-Trafficking Law Extension. Amendment that would add provisions to extend for four years a 2000 law that provides protections and assistance programs to trafficking victims. The amendment would create a grant program to fund services for sex trafficking victims and expand law enforcement grants for prosecuting trafficking crimes. It would criminalize the confiscation or destruction of a passport or other immigration document. It also would call on the State Department to establish anti-trafficking partnerships with the private sector and make a plan to prevent child marriage, and coordinate with the Labor Department on anti-trafficking issues. **Amendment Adopted.** *NAPO Supported.*
2. **Vote #16:** S.47 – Violence Against Women Act Reauthorization -- Trafficking Victim Assistance. Amendment that would allow underage sex trafficking victims to receive assistance under grants provided to help children exposed to violence. **Amendment Adopted.** *NAPO Supported.*
3. **Vote #17:** S.47 - Violence Against Women Reauthorization -- Duplicative Government Programs. Amendment that would direct the Justice Department to eliminate or consolidate its programs and use as much as 75 percent of the resulting savings to reduce a backlog in DNA evidence testing from cases involving rape, sexual assault and other crimes. It would redirect any leftover savings for debt reduction. **Amendment Rejected.** *NAPO Opposed.*
4. **Vote #19:** S.47 – Violence Against Women Act Reauthorization -- Passage. Bill that would reauthorize the Violence Against Women Act for five years. The law, which expired in 2011, provides protections and assistance programs to victims of domestic violence, sexual assault and stalking. The bill would authorize funds for law enforcement training programs, prosecution and victim services. It would give American Indian tribal courts additional authority over non-tribal domestic violence offenders. It would make it illegal for victim services organizations that receive grant funding through the law to discriminate on the basis of gender identity or sexual orientation. As amended, the bill also would extend through 2017 a law that provides protections and assistance programs to trafficking victims. It would allow underage sex-trafficking victims to receive assistance under grants provided to help children exposed to violence. **Bill Passed.** *NAPO Supported.*
5. **Vote #97:** S.649 – Gun Policy Revisions -- Background Checks. Amendment that would expand an existing background check system to include firearms purchased at gun shows and over the Internet. It would allow gun show sales to proceed if a background check does not prompt a response within 48 hours and reduce that to a 24-hour wait four years after enactment. It would exempt family transfers and some private sales. The amendment would restrict law enforcement grant funds for states that do not provide all available records to the national background check database. It would ban the creation of a national firearms registry, allow active-duty military members buy guns in their home state and create a

commission to study the causes of mass violence in the United States. **Amendment Rejected.** *NAPO Opposed.*

6. **Vote #98:** S.649 – Gun Policy Revisions -- GOP Substitute. Amendment that would reauthorize grants to help states use the national background check database. It would require federal courts to submit records to the database and restrict federal grant funds to states that do not meet reporting requirements. It also would expand definitions of mental illness that prohibit individuals from owning guns, make it a federal crime to purchase firearms on behalf of people legally barred from owning them and call for a task force to investigate and prosecute attempted firearm purchases by felons and fugitives. It would prohibit the Justice Department from inducing licensed gun dealers to sell firearms to a straw purchaser unless department officials certify that certain safeguards are in place. It would call for a study on the causes of mass shootings, including the impact of violent video games, and reauthorize grant programs on school security, mental health and crime prevention. **Amendment Rejected.** *NAPO Supported.*
7. **Vote #104:** S.649 - Gun Policy Revisions -- Gun Owner Privacy. Amendment that would withhold 5 percent of law enforcement grant funds to states and localities that release gun-ownership data, with an exception for the release of data necessary for a criminal investigation or legal proceeding. **Amendment Adopted.** *NAPO Opposed.*
8. **Vote #178:** Perez Nomination -- Confirmation. Confirmation of President Barack Obama's nomination of Thomas E. Perez of Maryland to be Labor secretary. **Confirmed.** *NAPO Supported.*
9. **Vote #188:** Comey Nomination -- Confirmation. Confirmation of President Barack Obama's nomination of James B. Comey Jr. of Connecticut to be FBI director. **Confirmed.** *NAPO Supported.*
10. **Vote #276:** Johnson Nomination -- Confirmation. Confirmation of President Barack Obama's nomination of Jeh Charles Johnson of New Jersey to be secretary of the Homeland Security Department. **Confirmed.** *NAPO Supported.*
11. **Vote #48:** Adegbile Nomination -- Cloture. Motion to invoke cloture (thus limiting debate) on President Barack Obama's nomination of Debo P. Adegbile of New York to be assistant attorney general for the Justice Department's Civil Rights Division. **Motion Rejected.** *NAPO Opposed.*


1. **Vote #55:** S.47 - Violence Against Women Act Reauthorization -- Passage. The law, which expired in 2011, provides protections and assistance programs to victims of domestic violence, sexual assault and stalking. The bill would authorize funds for law enforcement training programs, prosecution and victim services. It would give American Indian tribal courts additional authority over non-tribal domestic violence offenders. It would make it illegal for victim services organizations that receive grant funding through the law to discriminate on the basis of gender identity or sexual orientation. It also would extend through 2017 a law that provides protections and assistance programs to trafficking victims. It would allow underage sex-trafficking victims to receive assistance under grants provided to help children exposed to violence. **Bill Passed.** *NAPO Supported.*
2. **Vote #144:** H.R. 180 – National Blue Alert Network -- Passage. Motion to suspend the rules and pass the bill that would direct the Justice Department, in coordination with states, local government and law enforcement agencies, to create a national Blue Alert communications network to disseminate information about crimes against police officers. The measure also would require the network's coordinator to develop guidelines to protect the civil liberties and privacy of law enforcement officers seriously injured or killed in the line of duty and their families. **Bill Passed.** *NAPO Supported.*
3. **Vote #195:** H.R. 2217 - Fiscal 2014 Homeland Security Appropriations -- Immigration Customs Enforcement Salaries and Expenses. Amendment that would reduce by \$43.5 million the amount provided for the Immigration Customs Enforcement Salaries and Expenses account, including a \$5.4 million reduction for the 287(g) program, in which state and local law enforcement officers are trained to enforce federal immigration law. It would increase by \$4.3 million the amount provided for the Office of the Secretary and Executive Management. **Amendment Rejected.** *NAPO Opposed.*
4. **Vote #210:** H.R. 2217 - Fiscal 2014 Homeland Security Appropriations -- Recommit. Motion to recommit the bill to the House Appropriations Committee and report it back immediately with an amendment that would increase by \$25 million the total provided for Federal Emergency Management Agency activities including state and local programs, training, exercises and technical assistance; state, local, and tribal emergency response training; and a pre-disaster mitigation grant program. It also would reduce by a total of \$10 million the amount provided for expenses for Homeland Security Department operations and the Office of the Under Secretary for Management. **Motion Rejected.** *NAPO Supported.*
5. **Vote #179:** H.R. 4120 - National Law Enforcement Museum Construction -- Passage. Motion to suspend the rules and pass the bill that would extend for three years, until Nov. 9, 2016, the authority of the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial Fund to construct a museum honoring law enforcement officers. **Bill Passed.** *NAPO Supported.*

6. **Vote #221:** H.R. 3530 – Anti-Trafficking Grants -- Passage. Motion to suspend the rules and pass the bill that would authorize \$25 million over five years for the Justice Department to award grants that help child trafficking victims and support efforts to punish perpetrators. It also includes a five-year, \$100 million renewal of certain programs under a 1990 anti-child-abuse law and an increase in the cap on the Justice Department's crime victim's fund. **Bill Passed.** *NAPO Supported.*
7. **Vote # 222:** H.R. 4225 – Sexual Exploitation Advertising -- Passage. Motion to suspend the rules and pass the bill that would criminalize advertisements for the sexual exploitation of children or other trafficking victims. **Bill Passed.** *NAPO Supported.*
8. **Vote #244:** H.R. 4660 - Fiscal 2015 Commerce-Justice-Science Appropriations -- Community Oriented Policing Services. Amendment that would increase by \$3 million the amount provided for the Community Oriented Policing Services program, intended for the technology grant program, and decrease by the same amount the amount provided for the Census Bureau. **Amendment Adopted.** *NAPO Supported.*
9. **Vote #249:** H.R. 4660 - Fiscal 2015 Commerce-Justice-Science Appropriations -- National Instant Criminal Background Check System. Amendment that would increase by \$19.5 million the amount provided for the National Instant Criminal Background Check System to upgrade criminal mental health records, and reduce: by \$1 million the amount provided for Commerce Department activities, by \$3 million the amount provided for Justice for information sharing technology, by \$5.5 million the amount provided for Federal Prison System buildings and facilities and by \$10 million the amount provided for National Science Foundation agency operations and award management. **Amendment Adopted.** *NAPO Supported.*
10. **Vote #251:** H.R. 4660 - Fiscal 2015 Commerce-Justice-Science Appropriations -- State and Local Law Enforcement. Amendment that would increase by \$8.5 million the amount provided for state and local law enforcement assistance grants and contracts and decrease by the same amount the amount provided for NASA construction activities. **Amendment Rejected.** *NAPO Supported.*
11. **Vote #255:** H.R. 4660 - Fiscal 2015 Commerce-Justice-Science Appropriations -- One Percent Reduction. Amendment that would reduce all accounts in the bill by 1 percent, except those for the FBI, fees and expenses of witnesses, public safety officer benefits and the U.S. Trustee System Fund. **Amendment Rejected.** *NAPO Opposed.*
12. **Vote #268:** H.R. 4660 - Fiscal 2015 Commerce-Justice-Science Appropriations -- Recommit. Motion to recommit the bill to the House Appropriations Committee and report it back immediately with an amendment which would increase by \$1 million each, funds provided in the bill for Violence Against Women Prevention and Prosecution programs, grants to combat violence against women, State and Local Law Enforcement Assistance and grants to address backlogs of sexual assault kits. It would increase by \$3 million each, funds provided in the bill for Community Oriented Policing Services and for hiring under this program. **Motion Rejected.** *NAPO Supported.*
13. **Vote #269:** H.R. 4660 - Fiscal 2015 Commerce-Justice-Science Appropriations -- Passage. Passage of the bill that would provide \$51.2 billion in discretionary funds in fiscal 2015 for the departments of Commerce and Justice and other agencies such as NASA and the National Science Foundation. It would provide \$8.4 billion for the Commerce Department and \$28.1 billion for the Justice Department, including \$8.5 billion for the FBI, \$7 billion for the federal prison system and \$2.2 billion for state and local enforcement and crime prevention grant programs. The bill would provide \$17.9 billion for NASA, \$7.4 billion for the National Science Foundation, \$5.3 billion for the National Oceanic Atmospheric Administration and \$3.5 billion for the Patent and Trademark Office. **Bill Passed.** *NAPO Supported.*

14. **Vote #286:** H.R. 4754 – Transportation-HUD Appropriations -- License Plate Numbers. Amendment that would bar the use of funds in the bill to acquire a camera used for collecting or storing vehicle license plate numbers. **Amendment Adopted.** *NAPO Opposed.*

## NAPO SUPPORT BY STATE




